REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS #21-025 FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR THE ALAMEDA MAIN STREET FERRY TERMINAL REFURBISHMENT PROJECT

Reference is made to that certain REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS #21-025 for the Alameda Main Street Ferry Terminal Refurbishment Project Construction Management Services, issued by the San Francisco Bay Area Water Emergency Transportation Authority ("WETA") on October 20, 2021 (together with any Addenda, the "RFP").

This notice shall constitute formal written notification to the Proposers of WETA's intent to award the agreement to Jacobs.

On January 13, 2022, the WETA Board will consider a contract award for this project to Jacobs. Formal award shall only occur as and when, if at all, the WETA Board takes such action. Nothing in this notice modifies or alters the terms of the RFP, including WETA's reserved rights thereunder, which shall remain in full force and effect.
